



Summary of Fireworks Ordinances In the Eastside Fire & Rescue Service Area

Eastside Fire & Rescue encourages you and your family to attend a public fireworks display to enjoy fireworks. However, if you choose to celebrate with your own fireworks, please do it safely and follow these regulations for the area you live in.

Each City within Eastside Fire & Rescue has different regulations when it comes to using and selling fireworks.

City of Carnation

Professional public displays are allowed in the city of Carnation with permit.

No fireworks shall be sold within the city limits of Carnation.

No common fireworks shall be discharged within the city limits of Carnation.
(except for sparklers)

City of Issaquah

Professional public displays are allowed in the city of Issaquah with permit.

No person shall offer for wholesale or retail sale or sell any fireworks within the City.

No person shall ignite, explode or discharge any fireworks within the City.

City of North Bend

Professional public displays are allowed in the city of North Bend with permit.

Retail sale and discharge of fireworks.

A. Only common fireworks are legal for sale to the public.

B. It is unlawful to sell fireworks to any persons under the age of 16 years. The seller shall require proof of age by means of display of a Washington State



driver's license or photo identification card issued by the Washington State Department of Licensing. No other forms of identification shall be accepted.

C. The sale of any fireworks prior to 12:00 noon on June 28th or after 11:00 p.m. on July 4th of each year is prohibited, except where otherwise provided in this chapter.

D. The possession, use or discharge of any fireworks are prohibited at all times, except between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on July 4th each year, except where otherwise provided in this chapter.

City of Sammamish

Professional public displays are allowed in the city of Sammamish.

It is unlawful for any person to sell any fireworks within the City.

No person shall ignite, explode or discharge any fireworks within the City.
