February 2012 Bond Proposal Fact Sheet

1. King County Fire Protection District 10 (FD10) will seek voter approval for a \$5.5M bond that will cost approximately 9 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value for a period of 20 years. For example, a house valued at \$400,000 would pay \$36 per year.
2. The bond would fund a new fire station in the May Valley area as the current station is located on the far edge of its response area. By building a new station it will more effectively cover a larger area and decrease response times to a larger portion of the service area.
3. The bond would also make operational upgrades to other facilities serving Preston, May Valley, Lake Kathleen, Maple Hills, Tiger Mt., Klahanie, Brookshire, Hunters Glen, Livingston, High Point, Lake Joy, greater Issaquah, and the City of Carnation.
4. The ballot measure requires a 60% approval rate with validation from the last general election.
