



Eastside Fire & Rescue Fireworks Ordinances

Proudly Serving Issaquah, North Bend, Sammamish, Woodinville, and Fire Districts 38 & 10, which includes Carnation

Fireworks are banned in King County, with a few exceptions listed below. Eastside Fire & Rescue encourages you and your family to attend a public fireworks display. Each city, within Eastside Fire & Rescue's service area, has different regulations when it comes to using and selling fireworks. Please visit the appropriate city website for the complete City Ordinance.

Unincorporated King County (KCC 6.26)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- It is unlawful for any person to sell, ignite, explode, or discharge any fireworks within unincorporated King County.

City of Carnation (Chapter 8.24 of CMC)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- It is unlawful for any person to sell, ignite, explode, or discharge any fireworks within the city – with the exception of sparklers.

City of Issaquah (Chapter 8.12 IMC)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- It is unlawful for any person to sell, ignite, explode, or discharge any fireworks within the city.

City of North Bend (Chapter 8.20 NBMC)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- State approved fireworks will be sold from 12:00 noon on June 28th to 11:00 p.m. on July 4th.
- They may be discharged between 9:00 a.m. and midnight on July 4th only.

City of Sammamish (Chapter 8.10 SMC)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- It is unlawful for any person to sell, ignite, explode, or discharge any fireworks within the city.

City of Woodinville (Chapter 8.03 WMC)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- It is unlawful for any person to sell, ignite, explode, or discharge any fireworks within the city.

City of Duvall (Chapter 5.10 Code of Ordinances)

- Professional public displays are allowed with a permit.
- State approved fireworks will be sold from 12:00 noon on June 28th to 9:00 p.m. on July 5th.
- They may be discharged between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 pm on July 4th only.
